The MCP BROKER project aims to provide public cultural institutions with tools to improve the management of cultural diversity and to foster cultural participation of migrants in 5 European countries (Austria, Belgium, Italy, Spain and Sweden).

The project is funded by the European Commission-Directorate General Home Affairs and coordinated by Interarts (Spain) with the participation of Eccom (Italy), Educult (Austria), Intercult (Sweden), and the Platform for Intercultural Europe / Culture Action Europe (Belgium).

PHASES

1. Benchmarking Tool to establish the level of **management of diversity in public cultural institutions**.

2. Pilot studies on the status of diversity management in public cultural institutions in **5 European countries**, applying the Benchmarking Tool.

3. Learning Partnerships to promote integration of migrants **through cultural activities**, with a total of 60 to 90 organizations (public cultural institutions, NGOs, employment agencies and schools) in 5 European countries.

4. **Dissemination of the results** of the project through the social media, documentary films, a final public conference in 2015, etc.
